

# Special Needs Advisory Council (SNAC)

## SNAC Funding Request Guidelines

For families, and professionals, and benefiting children on IEP's or 504 Plans

**Purpose:** Assist in training and support for parents and families.

Educational supports: workshops and seminars.

Inclusionary Support: after- school weekend or summer enrichment programs, therapy, tutoring or counseling sessions for students.

**Administration:** SNAC will consider and administer funding requests, which are subject to full or partial approval by a subcommittee of the Board of Directors, at monthly meetings.

**Guidelines:** Applicants must be family members, guardians, or professionals of students currently on IEP's or 504 plans.

**Awards:** Applicants may receive up to \$160.00 per calendar year.

**Information:** Each application must include program details (i.e. program brochure or emailed information).

**Deadlines:** Funding allocations are based on the school year. Applications are due on or before **October 15<sup>th</sup>** for fall and winter programs and **May 15<sup>th</sup>** for spring and summer programs.

**Payment:** If funding application has been accepted, a check will be issued and payable to the program for which the grant is approved.
