FINALISTS ANNOUNCED FOR NANTUCKET SUPERINTENDENT POSITION

NANTUCKET—The Nantucket School Committee will soon begin consideration of the four finalists presented to the Committee to serve as Superintendent of Schools. The finalists were announced on Tuesday, January 29 by the appointed Search Committee, which was chaired by Dr. Timothy Lepore.

The finalists are **Dr. David W. Buck**, Superintendent of Schools, Wright City R-II School District, MO; **Dr. Elizabeth Hallett**, Director of Secondary Education, English Learner Education and Academic Programs, Quincy Public Schools, Quincy, MA; **Dr. Susan E. Kustka**, Assistant Superintendent of Administration and Personnel, Weymouth Public Schools, Weymouth, MA; and **Glenn G. Robbins**, Superintendent of Schools, Tabernacle Township School District, Tabernacle, NJ. The finalists were selected from a pool of 19 applicants.

Dr. Buck has served as Superintendent of Schools in Wright City R-II School District since 2015. He previously served at Assistant Superintendent in Wright City from 2008-2015, as well as High School Principal at Warrenton High School and Fatima High School, MO from 2002-2008. He has a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership and Policy Analysis in the Curriculum and Instruction Department, and a Doctorate of Education from Missouri Baptist University.

Dr. Hallett has served the Director of Secondary Education, English Learner Education and Academic Programs for the Quincy Public Schools since 2012. She also taught Sheltered English Instruction and English as a Second Language for the Quincy Schools. She earned a Master's Degree in Teaching English as a Second Language from Simmons University, and a Doctorate from the University of New England in Educational Leadership.

Dr. Kustka has served as the Assistant Superintendent of Administration and Personnel for the Weymouth Public Schools since 2013. She worked previously as the Director for Teaching and Learning and as Assistant Principal for the Hanover Public Schools, as well as a teacher in Plymouth and Scituate, MA. She received a Master's Degree in Moderate Special Needs from Boston College, an Advanced Degree (CAGS) in Interdisciplinary Studies from Fitchburg State University, and a Doctorate in Curriculum, Teaching, Learning, and Leadership from Northeastern University.

Glenn Robbins has served as Superintendent of Schools for the Tabernacle Township School District, NJ since 2016. He previously served as Principal of Northfield Community Middle School, NY, as well as Vice Principal and Teacher in Egg Harbor Township, NJ. He received a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership and Administration from Jones International University and a Doctorate in Educational Leadership from the American College of Education.
