State Tournament Post Season Game Play

NHS Varsity Boys Tennis

On Monday (6/3/19) the NHS varsity boys tennis team made school history hosting # 18 Bourne High School in a Preliminary Round State Tournament match. Monday's match was the very first post season match for this new Whaler athletic team. The Whalers made further history by defeating the "Canalmen" 4-1 in Monday's match, and becoming the very first Whaler tennis team to win a State Tournament match. In the Bourne match Luke Mackay won the # 1 singles match (6-0 / 6-1); John Vento won the # 2 singles match (6-2 / 6-1); Torin Boukus and Marsh Hickman won the # 1 doubles match ((6-3 / 6-2); and Will Harris and Evan Belanger won the # 2 doubles match (6-4 / 6-3).

On Wednesday (6/5) the Whalers traveled to # 2 Old Rochester Regional High School for a Division 3 South Sectional Round 1 game. The Whalers' played well, but their 2019 season came to an end with a 5 - 0 lost to the more experienced # 2 "Bulldogs". Our boys won games in every set of every match played on Wednesday and gained valuable experience against a top notch opponent. We are very proud of all.

The boys tennis team finished the season with a final overall record of 9 wins - 7 losses.
