

CPS Summer Reading 2018

One-Pager Assignment for Book 1 - Your Book Club Choice

A “one-pager” is assigned to promote thoughtful appreciation and understanding of a novel. The more creative you allow yourself to be, the more you will get out of the reading assignment. One-pagers, when done well, also provide a terrific review that can inspire others to read your book. This will be collected on the first day of school (September 4, 2018) for grading. Your one-pager will be returned to you for sharing at your book club meeting that first Friday of school (September 7, 2018).

Directions:

Use white, unlined computer paper, either 8 ½ x 11 OR 8 ½ x 14. This is NOT poster-size! Include the following:

1. Title of novel and author’s name.
2. Border - the border of the page should represent the theme of your book. It can be identified through images, words or quotes from the text.
3. “I believe statement” This should show what you are thinking and your opinion connected to the text. Ex. “I believe Brian showed courage by being honest about what happened at Sarah’s house.”
4. Create and Answer 2 questions about the book. These questions should showcase your comprehension of the book and be able to start discussions.
5. Include 2 important quotes from the book and explain why they are significant. Be sure to include page numbers the quotes can be found on!
6. Draw an image (character, scene, symbol, etc.) from your book.
7. Include a “word cloud” around your drawn image. This should be at least 10 words that connect to the image drawn.

Be colorful and neat. Your entire page should be filled with these elements. If you have more room, you can repeat any of these steps. No space should be left blank, and nothing should be left in pencil. Use colored pencils, markers (not Sharpies), and pens.
