Dear Nantucket High School Senior,

Thank you for your interest in the Nantucket Golf Club Foundation's Nantucket Vocational Scholarship Program. The Foundation will again select seniors who have exhibited exemplary work in a vocational program, internship, summer employment, or similar experience. Each selected student will receive a partial scholarship to the college, university, or technical school of their choice. To be eligible, a student must be enrolling in a program, in the 2022-2023 school year, that leads to employment in their chosen vocational field directly upon graduation from said program. (Examples of vocational programs include, but are not limited to, automotive, plumbing, woodworking, welding, photography, culinary, architecture, nursing, occupational therapy, marine engineering, and physical therapy.)

The first step for you is to download the application and bring one copy of your completed application and all required documents to Courtney Foster in the Nantucket High School Guidance Office on or before 3:00 p.m. on Friday, February 25, 2022, without exception. Two *confidential* recommendations must also be submitted by the recommender directly to Courtney Foster on or before 3:00 p.m., on Friday, February 25, 2022.
