SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

Statutory Information

The Nantucket Public Schools is a department of the town operated under laws pertaining to education and under regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Education. The area served by the Nantucket Public Schools is coterminous with the Town of Nantucket.

Legal Reference

The legal basis for public education in the district is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Constitution of Massachusetts and state statutes pertaining to education.

Under the General Laws of Massachusetts,

"...Every town shall maintain...a sufficient number of schools for the instruction of all children who may legally attend a public school therein."
