## GIFTED AND TALENTED EDUCATION

"Gifted and talented" students are those students who demonstrate outstanding performance or the assessed potential for such performance or whose abilities, talents and potential for accomplishment in one or more areas of endeavor are so outstanding that they require special provisions to meet their educational needs.

The primary objective of a gifted and talented education is to be responsive to individual student needs and provide a variety of options for gifted students. These options should include, but are not limited to, higher level learning activities and experiences, opportunity for independent study, access to multiple resources and intellectual peer interaction.
