Birth to Three!



The Department of Public Health provides services to Nantucket for children aged birth to three through the Cape Cod Child Development Early Intervention Program (EI). The purpose of this program is to identify young children who may be demonstrating developmental delays/ differences or are at-risk due to medical and/ or family history. After identification, early intervention and support can be provided to the family. Services are delivered either in the home setting or through community playgroups. Turning Three...



The transition from EI to Nantucket Public School (NPS)

- Given parent permission, information is shared with NPS on services being provided
- At 2 years 6 months, EI sends transition notification and a transition meeting takes place with the family and a NPS representative
- The transition meeting provides information of services available through NPS
- At 2 years 9 months, a TEAM meeting takes place to determine eligibility of continued services
- An individualized educational plan is developed after eligibility is determined
- A placement decision is made for classroom or OutReach services



<u>NPS services for</u> <u>3-5 year olds</u>



NPS provides an array of services to the preschool age community based on individual need.

The elementary school houses **2 Pathways Pre**school Programs for students demonstrating moderate to severe needs. The **Pathways**

OutReach program offers additional services such as:

- Community wide screening days, 3 times a year and ongoing appointments as needed
- Kids Connect classroom that focuses on communication, motor and cognitive skills
- Consultation to other preschool programs regarding behavior management, speech and language development or overall child development
- Collaboration with the Cape Cod Early Intervention Team
