ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Your child's safety is our primary concern. Your cooperation and support with the following procedures are greatly appreciated.

- Students may exit buses and cars at 7:35 AM when supervision is available and school doors open.
- At 7:35, Students make one choice each day until it is time to go to their classrooms.
 They can go to the K Cluster, 1st Grade Cluster, or the 2nd Grade Cluster for quiet reading, homework, etc. Another choice, students may go to the gym for Walk and Talk
- Students are expected to be in classrooms ready to learn at 7:50 AM. Please arrive by 7:45 AM.
- Students arriving prior to 7:35 AM should register for Breakfast Buddies program as there is no other adult supervision provided prior to that time.
- Parents driving children to school should use the Backus Lane entrance and follow the drop off line around the side driveway loop. Please follow the directions of staff assisting your child's safe arrival.
- Bus Schedules are on our website, at school and they were mailed home. Your child's safety is our primary concern. Your cooperation and support with the following procedures are greatly appreciated.

- Dismissal will begin promptly at 2:20 pm.
- Drivers may not pull into the Bus Loop Circle to pick up their children.
- Parents who park in the Backus Lane lot will walk to meet their children. The
 children will be escorted by their teachers. Kindergarten students will come out the
 K door closest to the Ice Rink. First Grade students will walk out the Café doors.
 Second Grade students will walk out the Gym door.
- Students walking to parent pick up cars will be dismissed out the front doors after the buses have left. They will be grouped by grade level on the circular walkway loop between NES and NIS. Parents will drive right up and pick up all their children in one spot as the students from a family will stand in their youngest child's spot. You will access this loop via Backus Lane.
- There will be no drive through pick up in the K circle.
- If you wish to drive across the campus road, you must take a left out of the circle onto Backus and drive to the campus road.
- Walkers and Bike Riders will be dismissed out the front doors. They will meet one of three crossing guards on Surfside Road. Bikers must have helmets, walk bikes on campus, and everyone must cross with a crossing guard.

All visitors to NES must sign in at the Front Office. You will need to turn in your identification, and you will receive a badge to wear while you are in the building.

If a child needs to miss 5 or more days, please schedule an appointment with the principal to discuss this extended absence. Please set this appointment up well in advance of the extended absence if possible.
